FLOAT PURCHASE AGREEMENT

Clamar Technologies Inc., an Ontario, Canada Registered company, referred to as Clamar, is the manufacturer of the Model 3500A/3500 series Floats, referred to as Floats. Floats have a fresh water displacement of 3480 and 3654 pounds and are offered as an option for non-certified aircraft. The undersigned individual referred to as Purchaser understands and agrees to the following terms, conditions, and requirements.

FAA/MOT CERTIFICATION

The Floats require inspection and certification for use by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) under the provisions of the Federal Aviation Regulations (FAR's) Purchaser has read and thoroughly understands the FAR's as they apply to the certification and operation of homebuilt aircraft in the Experimental Category.

Purchaser understands and agrees that certification of the Floats is dependent on Purchaser's installation techniques and resultant airworthiness. Purchaser also understands and agrees that Clamar accepts no certification responsibility.

FLOAT DESIGN AND INSTALLATION INTEGRITY

Purchaser understands and agrees that many factors affect the design and integrity of the Floats, including the design requirements for structural integrity of attachment to aircraft and aquadynamic and center-of-gravity characteristics. Clamar provides attachment hardware and strut material for the Murphy Super Rebel. Installation design for other aircraft is the sole responsibility of Purchaser. Purchaser agrees not to make any modification or substitution of any component part of the Floats.

Clamar reserves the right to make revisions in the construction of the Floats at any time without liability to Clamar, as such revisions or changes may be deemed advisable from time to time.

ACCIDENT LIABILITY

Purchaser understands and agrees that many factors beyond the control of Clamar significantly affect the operational safety of the Floats installed by them, including the quality of the aircraft as constructed by Purchaser or others, the attachment of the Floats to the aircraft as undertaken by the Purchaser or others, the performance by Purchaser or others of inspections, maintenance procedures, and repairs, or the operation of the aircraft, including high impact, rough water, excessive weight, high take off or landing speeds, etc. by Purchaser or others.

Purchaser also understands and agrees that the installation, maintenance, and/or repair of any aircraft or Float may involve use of tools, equipment, and construction methods that may present safety hazards that are beyond the control of Clamar.

Clamar does not warrant the integrity of the Floats after they have been shipped from the factory. Purchaser agrees to inspect the Floats and all component parts, prior to installation, for shipping or other damage.

Purchaser accepts sole responsibility for the installation and operation of the Floats. Purchaser RELEASES Clamar from any liability for any bodily injury or property damage arising from his installation, maintenance, or operation of any Float equipped aircraft and agrees to INDEMNIFY Clamar for any such claim by third party. Purchaser understands that the cost of these Floats would be substantially higher should such waiver of liability and indemnification not be made.

The entire risk as to performance of the Floats is with the Purchaser. Floats are provided "AS IS" with out express or implied warranty of any kind, including merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose. Should the Floats or installation prove defective, the Purchaser (and not Clamar) assumes the entire cost of all necessary servicing, repair, or correction.

PROPRIETARY INFORMATION

Purchaser understands that the Floats are supplied to them solely to enable them to be installed on their kit or other non-certified aircraft. Purchaser agrees to prevent any Clamar proprietary information from being diverted from its intended use. Purchaser specifically agrees: (a) not to copy or permit others to copy any Float instruction manuals, (b) not to duplicate or permit others to duplicate any parts supplied to him by Clamar and (c) not to trace, photograph, or otherwise record dimensional information from parts supplied to him by Clamar, or to permit other to do the same.

OWNERSHIP OR ADDRESS CHANGE

Purchaser understands and agrees that it may be necessary for Clamar to communicate to Float owners and operators information relating to Float safety such as changes in design, construction, or operation procedures. Purchaser agrees to keep Clamar informed of the name and address of any individual who is responsible for the installation or operation of the Floats purchased by him.

Purchaser also agrees to notify Clamar immediately of the sale of the Floats purchased by him, whether installed or not, and to promptly supply Clamar with the complete name and address of the new owner.

YOU ARE THE FINAL INSPECTOR

Clamar is very conscientious to assure that the proper items are delivered. It is your responsibility, however, to inventory the parts supplied with the Floats against the enclosed parts list. If there are any discrepancies in your order, Clamar must be notified within 30 days of receiving your Floats for any necessary adjustments.

If any damage has occurred to your Floats during shipment, please call your trucking company and Clamar immediately. It is our intent to assure the delivery of quality Floats. If you have any problems, please contact Clamar for any necessary corrections.

PROVINCIAL SALES TAX (PST)

Any Floats or parts delivered inside the Province of Ontario are subject to PST. If the state or country to which a product is delivered subjects such product to sales, use, or added value taxation, Purchaser agrees to pay any such tax. GST will apply to all sales in Canada.

PAYMENT & REFUND POLICIES

Orders for Floats are accepted upon receipt of deposit, receipt of signed purchase agreement, and a written acknowledgement of the order (including confirmation of purchase price) by Clamar. Purchaser understands that all prices are subject to change without notice prior to acceptance of order. All deposits are applied to the purchase price of the Floats, and are nonrefundable for any reason. Full payment is due prior to Floats shipment. All shipping charges are collect. Pick up of Floats at factory is an available option.

DELIVERY SCHEDULE POLICIES

Clamar assigns delivery dates in the order of acceptance. Purchaser understands and agrees that the delivery date is only an estimation, and that actual delivery may be advanced or delayed. Purchaser will be notified if the delivery date can be advanced, and may request within 15 days that it not be so advanced. Delivery dates may be postponed only at the discretion of Clamar. There is a negotiated charge for any postponement requested by Purchaser after 15 days of original order date.
